A New Year's Wish List

BVFD continues to need donations so that the new Fire House can be completed. The loan we received from USDA for the building shell and foundation has been well spent and we are now continuing construction using money that individual donors have generously provided to BVFD via our Brick Campaign and other cash donations. Our regular fund raisers also still provide some of the funds necessary to continue. We feel we can continue this way but the length of time remaining on our permit is winding down and getting occupancy before 9/12 is our goal. We are applying for grants for specific items in order to outfit the new station but we are not sure we will be able to secure any funds this way. Donations are needed for many items for completion. These are some of them:

- Emergency Standby Generator (\$17,000)
- Equipment, furniture, appliances (TV) for the training room (\$5000)
- Chairs and furniture for the office and day room (\$4000)
- Projection equipment for training (\$1000)
- 30-40 folding or stacking chairs (\$3000)
- Kitchen appliances, including stove, refrigerator, dishwasher (\$6000)
- Pots, pans, dishes, utensils (\$1000)
- Heavy duty washer and drier (\$2500)
- Air compressor (\$1000)
- Two new computers (\$1400)
- Landscaping materials (\$3000)
- Materials for cabinets, a local cabinet maker will be donating labor to build them (\$7000)

Many of the items mentioned are specified in the plans and must be new, used equipment or materials though appreciated, are not being asked for at this time. A small plaque will be placed noting the donation if it fully outfits a specific room.

Please consider giving a New Year's gift to your trusted volunteer fire department. We can never let up on supporting our community. We are all volunteers.
